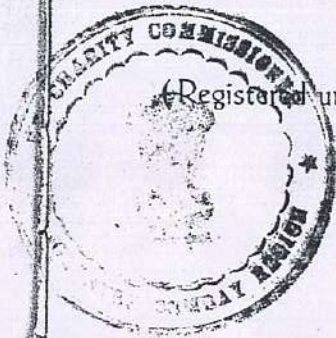

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

OF THE

"VICTORIA JUBILEE TECHNICAL INSTITUTE."

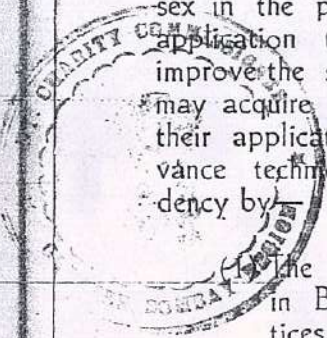
(Registered under Act XXI of 1860 on the 27th November 1888.)

1. The name of the Society is the "VICTORIA JUBILEE TECHNICAL INSTITUTE." Title.

2. The objects for which the Society is established are to impart instruction to persons of either sex in the principles of science and art, and their application to industrial or other purposes, and to improve the status and position of such persons as may acquire proficiency in the said principles and their application as, aforesaid and generally to advance technical education in the Bombay Presidency by— Object.

(1) The establishment of a Central Institution in Bombay for the instruction of apprentices, workmen, foremen, managers and for training suitable Technical Teachers for the whole of the Presidency. Instruction of apprentices, etc.

(2) The supervision and control as regard staff accommodation, equipment, courses of instruction, methods of work, standards and conduct of examinations, nature and grant of certificates, diplomas or licenses of such technical and industrial schools as may be affiliated with or subordinated to the Central Institution. Supervision and control of Technical Schools, etc.



Holding of examinations and granting of diplomas.

(3) The holding of examinations ~~other than as provided for in clause 2 (2)~~ in Technology in any manner that may appear practical and the granting of certificates of competency to those who satisfy the prescribed tests.

(4) Advising Government from time to time as to the condition of technical education in the Presidency and the measures necessary or desirable for its general advancement including the conditions under which new schools or classes may be established with the assistance of Government.

† 3. The business of the Institute shall be conducted by a Governing Body or Board of Trustees the Members of which shall be appointed in the manner set out in Rules and Regulations of the Institute.
